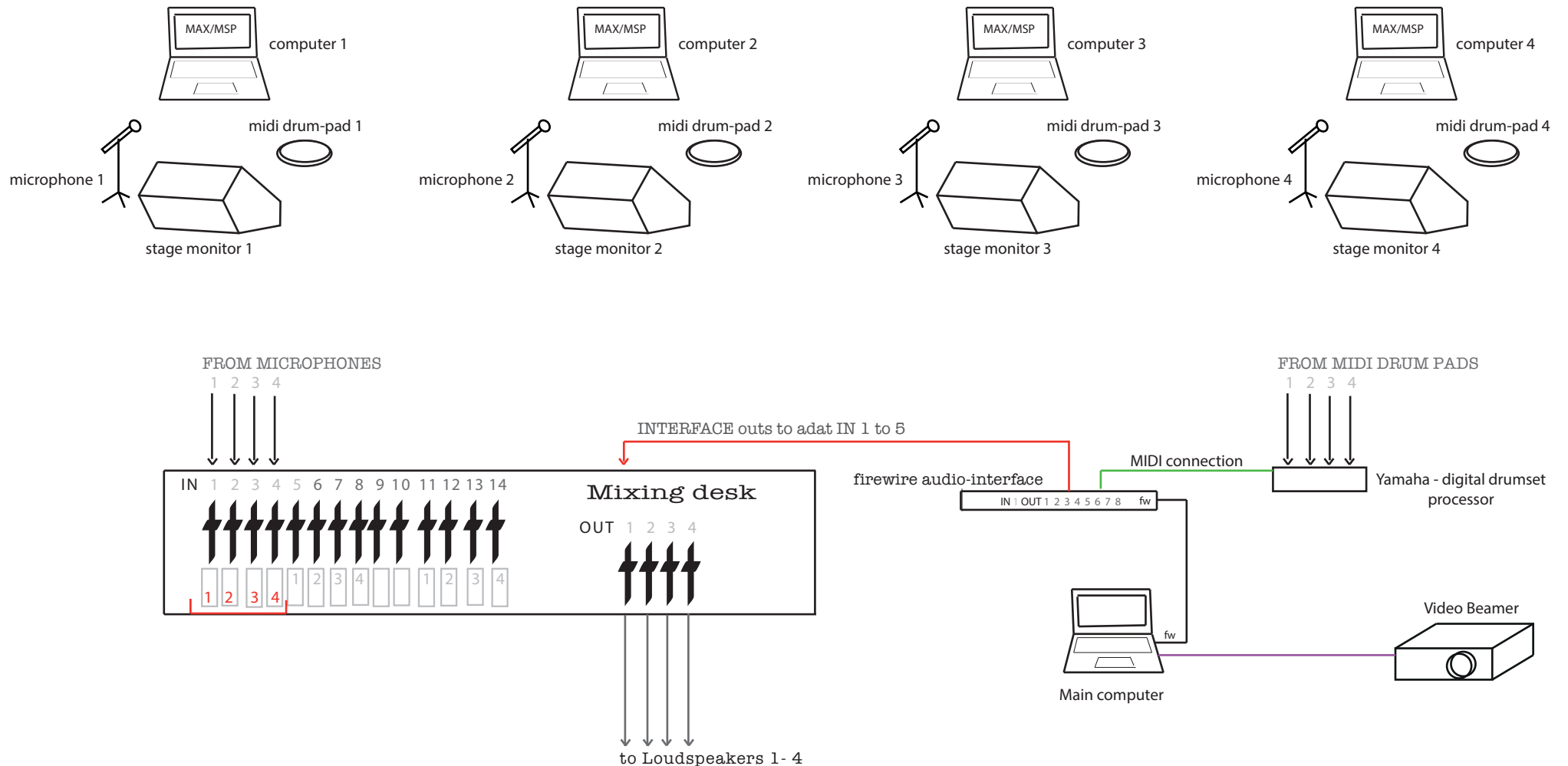


Desplazados

Technical Details



- _ All five computers are connected via a WIFI network
- _ Each output is routed to its corresponding loudspeaker only
- _ All channels are low-pass filtered and connected to the subwoofer
- _ Please provide electrical power for each computer on stage
- _ If no ADAT input available, the sound card can be plugged into the mixing desk using analog cables (in that case, please provide 4 male-male jack to XLR adapters)

T e c h n i c a l D e t a i l s

Material provided by the venue or the festival:

- 1 video projector (depending on the venue, an ultra-short throw beamer could be an ideal choice, retro projection recommended)**
- 1 big screen or wall for projection**
- 1 HDMI cable (at least 10 meters long - from computer to video projector)**
- 4 small microphone stands (for the cardioide microphones, table mic stands are welcome!)**
- PA system (mixing desk, stereo speakers, or quad setup surrounding the audience + 1 or 2 subwoofers)**
- 8 XLR cables (long enough to connect the microphones and midi drumpads to the main computer and the mixing desk)**
- 8 XLR to Jack male-male adapters (or cables)**
- 4 XLR to Jack female-male adapters (or cables)**
- 4 wedges (stage monitors)**
- DARK ROOM (The only light sources must be the computers' screens.)**
- 4 Swiss to Chilean 220 V plug adapter _ For Colombia: 4 Swiss to Colombian 110V plug adapters**
- 4 power- chord extensions (10 m)**
- 4 electrical multi-sockets**
- 4 stools or small seats**

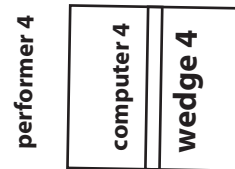
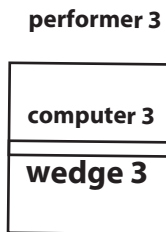
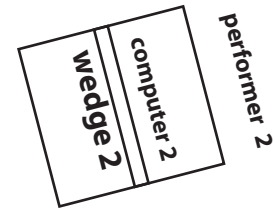
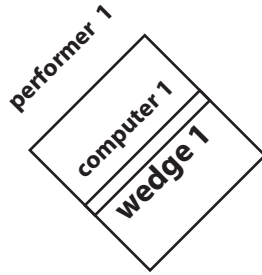
Material provided by Ensemble Vortex:
